





## **DOCUWEEKS 2011 CALL FOR ENTRIES**

<u>DocuWeeks 2011</u> is the <u>International Documentary Association (IDA)</u> 15th Annual theatrical showcase qualifying documentary features and shorts for the Academy Awards. DocuWeeks helps to qualify outstanding new feature and short documentaries for Academy Award® consideration, by providing its participants a commercial theatrical exhibition in Los Angeles and New York.

Final submission **deadline May 10**, 2011. Discounted entry fee for earlier submission. Entries accepted online at <u>Withoutabox</u>.

Among other requirements, to be eligible for consideration for the 84th Academy Awards®, a feature documentary film must complete a seven-day commercial theatrical run (screening twice daily) in the County of Los Angeles *and* in the Borough of Manhattan between September 1, 2010, and December 31, 2011. Short documentaries must complete a seven-day commercial theatrical run (screening once per day) in the County of Los Angeles *or* in the Borough of Manhattan.

DocuWeeks provides one-week theatrical runs in Los Angeles and New York City, as well as the required advertising and publicity support. If selected to participate in DocuWeeks a participation fee of \$4,500 for short films and \$14,000 to \$20,000 for feature films will be required.

Please see the <u>84th Annual Academy Awards Rules for</u> complete eligibility and Academy Award® application requirements. Each filmmaker is responsible for submitting their Academy Awards® application. IDA will provide the filmmaker with proof of advertisement and theatrical runs for submission to the Academy prior to the Academy deadline.
