





CALL FOR ENTRIES: Producers Showcase_PROSHOW

The Producers Guild of America (PGA) announced the launch of the 2011 PGA Producers Showcase (ProShow) competition, taking place in conjunction with the third annual Produced By Conference (PBC) to be held June 3-5, 2011.

Expanded from last year's inaugural International Film Co-Production Showcase (CoProShow), which solicited entries from international film producers only, ProShow will now accept submissions for both international and domestic projects. Winners will receive free admission to this year's PBC where they will participate in one-on-one meetings with top Hollywood financiers, film commissions, studios and production companies. The goal of ProShow, which was developed by the PGA's International Committee, is to help film producers initiate business relationships, co-develop compelling projects and spearhead investment.
